We will also publish the technical and commercial information of manufacturing companies in the form of advertising. We plan to publish information about PM seminars and conferences that will be organised.

The members of the Editorial Board are scientist workers from the powder metallurgy branch in the Slovak Republic. The members of the International Advisory Board are reputable experts in powder metallurgy, with whom our institute has long-term co-operation and who support the idea to issue this journal. Many thanks to all of them and we believe, that their support will help us to create worthful journal and that they will contribute also to its publicity. In like manner, I thank also the co-editors who established the basic conditions for work of our editorial office.

Dear reader, we hope, that besides yours general interest in the new journal, you will become a regular contributor as well. On behalf of the members of the Editorial Office, I would like to ask you to not hesitate to send us yours remarks as to the content, to the journal design, and print quality. It will help us to improve the journal's level. The journal office's address is inscribed on the dust-cover, together with contact by e-mail, and reference to web page. At the same time, I should like to ask you for co-operation in journal publicity.

In the course of journal registration, we have intended to publish the journal 4x within a year. It is clear for us, that we have brought upon ourselves not an easy task. However, we believe that with a joint effort as well as with your interest concerning powder metallurgy development, and therefore also about the journal, we will able to manage it together.
